

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE STARK COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' 2016 MUNICIPAL ROAD FUND PROGRAM FOR AN ELTON STREET SW IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT, AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED**

WHEREAS, since 1969 the Stark County License Tax Fee has been set aside by the Stark County Commissioners to allocate moneys under the Municipal Road Fund Program for the improvement of streets in the Cities and Villages of the County that are necessary or conducive to the orderly and efficient flow of traffic within the County, and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Road Fund Program provides financial assistance to local subdivisions for capital improvements to public streets within Stark County municipalities, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Brewster is planning to make capital improvements to Elton Street SW through a Roadway Improvement Project, and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority for the community and is qualified under the Stark County Municipal Road Fund Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

**SECTION 1:** That the Brewster Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to file an application for the Stark County Commissioners' 2016 Municipal Road Fund Program for improvements to Elton Street SW within the Village corporation limits. Said improvements are to include the repair of severe rutting and cracking of the roadway, and the application of a minimum of a 2 ½" asphalt overlay to the road surface.

**SECTION 2:** That the Brewster Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding under the Municipal Road Fund Program. In addition, the Village Administrator is authorized to execute any contracts applicable to the project.

**SECTION 3:** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
