Resolution No. 2-2023 Passed January 3rd, 2023

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE AMENDMENT AND APPROPRIATION OF ADDITIONAL FUNDS FOR 2022 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Income Tax Collections have been higher than estimated for 2022 and;

WHEREAS, property tax collections were higher than expected, and;

WHEREAS, the Village has declared items no longer necessary and put the items up for public auction, and declared other items unusable and recycled those items, and;

WHEREAS, interest rates are starting to climb again, and;

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio provided additional grant money for Police CPT training, and;

WHEREAS, the Village has received or expects to receive around \$114,000 and \$13,500 in a grant money, and:

WHEREAS, the Village is received \$25,000 for Fire Equipment from Tuscarawas Township from their federal money from the ARP Act for the purchase of equipment, and;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, STARK COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1: There is hereby appropriated additional revenues as follows:

- \$ 177,050.00 for the General Fund
- \$ 16,100.00 for the Street CM&R Fund
- \$ 6,780.00 for the Cemetery Fund
- \$ 28,285.00 for the Parks & Grounds Fund
- \$ 39,982.00 for the Fire Operations Fund
- \$ 25,000.00 for the ARP Fund
- \$ 46,500.00 for the Street Improvement Fund
- \$ 35,000.00 for the Police Income Tax Fund
- \$ 114,000.00 for the Capital Construction Fund
- \$ 13,500.00 for the Water Replacement Fund

SECTION 2: This resolution is deemed an emergency in order to close the 2022 books.
