

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 18-2015 RELATING TO THE  
QUARTERLY TRANSFERS FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE RECREATION FUND,  
TO THE STREET RESURFACING FUND, TO THE STREET EQUIPMENT FUND, TO THE  
PARKS & GROUNDS FUND, TO THE POLICE CAR & EQUIPMENT FUND, AND TO  
THE SIDEWALK CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND**

WHEREAS, Brewster Village Council has determined the allocation of General Fund revenue needs to be adjusted to meet current expenses.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: Ordinance 18-2015 shall be amended as follows:

- The quarterly transfer from the General Fund to the Recreation Fund will be set at \$ 1500.00.
- The quarterly transfer from the General Fund to the Street Resurfacing Fund will be set at \$ 2500.00
- The quarterly transfer from the General Fund to the Street Equipment Fund will be set at \$ 7500.00
- The quarterly transfer from the General Fund to the Police Car & Equipment Fund will be set at \$ 8000.00
- The quarterly transfer from the General Fund to the Parks & Grounds Fund will be set at \$ 2500.00
- The quarterly transfer from the General Fund to the Sidewalk Capital Improvement Fund will continue at \$ 1500.00

SECTION 2: The above changes will be effective with the first quarter transfers, and shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
