

**AN ORDINANCE AWARING A CONTRACT FOR THE MCKINLEY
AVENUE ELECTRIC DISTRIBUTION LINE REBUILD PROJECT,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the advertisement for Bids for the McKinley Avenue Electric Distribution Line Rebuild Project has been completed in accordance with all applicable laws.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: It is determined that Thompson Electric was the lowest and best bidder for the McKinley Avenue Electric Distribution Line Rebuild Project has been completed in accordance in accordance with the specifications on which the Bids were received. The Bidder is to furnish all labor, supervision, tools, and equipment for the following:

Total Construction/Total Labor for the sum Total = \$ 204,000.00

SECTION 2: The Village Administrator and Village Clerk-Treasurer are authorized to enter into a contract with Thompson Electric for the completion of the McKinley Avenue Electric Distribution Line Rebuild Project in accordance with the specifications on which the Bids were received for the contract price of \$ 204,000.00

SECTION 3: The above cost for the McKinley Avenue Electric Distribution Line Rebuild Project shall be charged to the Electric Fund

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall be considered under emergency to allow construction to be completed prior to high electric usage months, and shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
