

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A THREE-YEAR CONTRACT WITH
TUSCARAWAS TOWNSHIP FOR FIRE PROTECTION AND AMBULANCE AND
RESCUE SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED BY THE BREWSTER FIRE DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, the Tuscarawas Township Trustees have requested fire protection and ambulance and rescue services for Tuscarawas Township from the Brewster Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, Brewster Village Council desires to provide fire protection and ambulance and rescue services through the Brewster Fire Department to Tuscarawas Township in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 505.44.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: The Village shall enter into a contract with Tuscarawas Township for the Brewster Fire Department to provide fire protection and ambulance and rescue services for three years from January 1, 2019 until midnight on December 31, 2021.

SECTION 2: Services and payments shall be as provided in the Contract submitted by Tuscarawas Township that will be on file at Village Hall to provide fire protection and ambulance and rescue services for at a cost to Tuscarawas Township at a minimum cost of \$ 69,907.50 per year.

SECTION 3: The terms of this contract shall be reviewed and approved by the Village Solicitor.

SECTION 4: The Mayor and Village Clerk are authorized to take any steps necessary or appropriate to consummate said contract.

SECTION 5: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
