## **AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT TO SUPPLY AND INSTALL REDUCED POWER POLES FOR FAIRLESS LOCAL SCHOOLS**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Brewster has removed a number of power poles that are no longer needed for municipal purpose; and

**WHEREAS**; Fairless Local Schools has expressed an interest in the Village supplying power poles, cut down in height (cut down to "wooden soldier height), and having those poles installed by our Electric Department adjacent to driveways and parking areas to prevent vehicles from attempting to leave the paved areas; and

**WHEREAS**, Fairless Schools will agree to pay the salaries of the Village employees who set the poles, as well as incidental costs (i.e. foam to set "bollards")


**WHEREAS**, Ohio Revised Code Section 9.482 authorizes contracting for services between political subdivisions; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:**

**SECTION 1;** The Village Administrator is authorized to enter into contract with Fairless Local Schools to supply power poles, cut down in height (cut down to "wooden soldier height), and having those poles installed by the Brewster Electric Department adjacent to driveways and parking areas to prevent vehicles from attempting to leave the paved areas.

**SECTION 2:** The Administrator is authorized and directed to execute said contract. An executed copy of the Contract shall be kept on file in the Village Clerk-Treasurer's Office.

**SECTION 3:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
