A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A ONE YEAR AGREEMENT WITH THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE LOCAL ORGANIZED GOVERNMENTS IN COOPERATION (L.O.G.I.C.) FOR FULL DISPATCHING SERVICES FOR THE VILLAGE FIRE DEPARTMENT AND THE VILLAGE POLICE DEPARTMENT BY THE REGIONAL EMERGENCY DISPATCHING (RED) CENTER

WHEREAS, Brewster Village Council has determined that it would be in the best interest of the Village to enter into an agreement with the Board of Trustees of the Local Organized Governments in Cooperation (hereafter L.O.G.I.C.) for full dispatching services for the Brewster Fire Department and the Brewster Police Department to be provided by the Regional Emergency Dispatch Center (hereafter RED Center) for 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: As outlined in the agreement submitted by L.O.G.I.C. on November ____, 2019 the cost of dispatching services shall be as follows:

(a) Dispatching of the Brewster Fire Department –

In 2020 the maximum sum of \$ 50.26 per call, for the sum total of \$ 41,364.00

(b) Dispatching of the Brewster Police Department –

In 2020 the maximum sum of \$ 11.51 per person, for the sum total of \$ 24,850.00

SECTION 2: Under Section 167.08 of the Ohio Revised Code the Village Mayor and the Village Clerk-Treasurer are authorized to enter into an agreement such as provided above by L.O.G.I.C. for full dispatching services for the Brewster Fire Department and the Brewster Police Department to be provided by the Regional Emergency Dispatch Center.

SECTION 3: The Village Mayor and the Village Clerk-Treasurer are authorized to take all steps required to enter into and fulfill an agreement with L.O.G.I.C. for full dispatching services of the Brewster Fire Department and the Brewster Police Department to be provided by the Regional Emergency Dispatch Center for 2020.


SECTION 4: This contract expires on December 31, 2020. Brewster can request early termination of the Contract prior to that date upon proof of financial hardship, if said termination is approved by L.O.G.I.C. This agreement can be modified should there be a change in the population due to a change of L.O.G.I.C. membership. This agreement also terminates if a Stark County Regional Dispatch operation occurs that replaces the dispatching operations provided by L.O.G.I.C.

SECTION 5: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.




