Ordinance No. 11-2023

Passed January 17, 2023

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF RENEWABLE ENERGY CREDITS IN 2023, 2024, AND 2025 THAT ARE RECEIVED FROM THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER'S PORTION OF THE OHIO MUNICIPAL ELECTRIC GENERATION AGENCY JOINT VENTURE AT THE BELLEVILLE HYDROELECTRIC PLANT (OMEGA JV5), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, in 1993 forty-two communities, including the Village of Brewster, participated in an American Municipal Power, Inc. (AMP) project to build and operate a 42-megawatt hydroelectric plant on the Ohio River, and

WHEREAS, this project known as OMEGA JV5 completed in 1999 provides Renewable Energy Credits which may be sold to qualified buyers via the Ohio Alternative Energy Portfolio Standard (AEPS), and

WHEREAS, Brewster Village Council desires to sell these Renewable Energy Credits as an OMEGA JV5 participant through American Municipal Power, Inc.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: Brewster Village Council authorizes American Municipal Power, Inc. to sell the Village of Brewster's portion of Renewable Energy Credits derived from OMEGA JV5 in 2023, 2024, and 2025 at the best price American Municipal Power, Inc. is able to obtain.

SECTION 2: The Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to provide all information and to complete any documentation required to sell the Village's share of the OMEGA JV5 Renewable Energy Credits.






