Ordinance No. 11-2024

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR, WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF THE RURAL COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE PARTNERSHIP (RCAP), TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, AND ENTER INTO A CONSTRUCTION LOAN AGREEMENT FOR AN OHIO EPA WATER POLLUTION CONTROL LOAN FUND (WPCLF) LOAN FOR THE INSTALLATION OF TWO (2) MANHOLES IN THE SANITARY SEWER LINE THAT RUNS BETWEEN MCKINLEY TO THE LEVEE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Brewster desires to proceed with the installation of two (2) manholes in the sanitary sewer line that runs between McKinley to the levee (Manhole Project); and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Brewster submitted a nomination to Ohio EPA Water Pollution Control Fund (WPCLF) to finance costs of the construction of said installation of two (2) manholes in the sanitary sewer line that runs between McKinley to the levee (Manhole Project); and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Brewster request for a nomination to Ohio EPA Water Pollution Control Fund (WPCLF) to finance costs of the construction of the installation of two (2) manholes in the sanitary sewer line that runs between McKinley to the levee (Manhole Project) has been approved; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Brewster desires to follow through and submit/obtain a loan from the Ohio EPA Water Pollution Control Fund (WPCLF) to finance costs of the construction of said installation of two (2) manholes in the sanitary sewer line that runs between McKinley to the levee (Manhole Project); and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Brewster, Ohio:**

**SECTION 1:** Authorize the Village Administrator to employ the services of the Rural Community Assistance Partnership (RCAP) to prepare and submit a loan application to the Ohio EPA Water Pollution Control Fund (WPCLF) to finance the costs of the construction of said installation of two (2) manholes in the sanitary sewer line that runs between McKinley to the levee (Manhole Project).

**SECTION 2:** Authorize the Village Administrator to accept grant funds from an Ohio EPA Water Pollution Control Fund (WPCLF) Loan to finance costs of the construction of said the installation of two (2) manholes in the sanitary sewer line that runs between McKinley to the levee (Manhole Project).

**SECTION 3:** The Village Administrator and Village Clerk-Treasurer are authorized and directed to execute and take all measures required to accept an Ohio EPA Water Pollution Control Fund (WPCLF) Loan to finance costs of the construction of said installation of two (2) manholes in the sanitary sewer line that runs between McKinley to the levee (Manhole Project).

**SECTION 4:** That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of said Village of Brewster for the reason that the installation of two (2) manholes in the sanitary sewer line that runs between McKinley to the levee (Manhole Project) has required emergency repairs, and bidding and construction needs to be completed as quickly as possible to allow the installation of two (2) manholes in the sanitary sewer line that runs between McKinley to the levee (Manhole Project) at the earliest possible time so that the Village can avoid potential flooding/damage to homes because the Village cannot clear backups; wherefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage.






