

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A TWO-YEAR CONTRACT WITH SUGARCREEK
TOWNSHIP FOR FIRE AND AMBULANCE SERVICE BY THE BREWSTER
VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Sugarcreek Township Trustees have requested fire protection and ambulance and rescue services for Sugarcreek Township from the Brewster Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, Brewster Village Council desires to provide fire protection and ambulance and rescue services to Sugarcreek Township in accordance with O.R.C. 505.44.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: The Village shall enter into a contract with Sugarcreek Township to provide fire protection and ambulance and rescue services for two years from February 22, 2019 until February 21, 2021.

SECTION 2: Services and payments shall be as provided in the Contract provided by Sugarcreek Township that will be on file at Village Hall. Payments to the Village shall be a sum determined by the net revenue generated from the Township Fire District Tax Levy and a formula based on past runs by the area fire departments. Based on the County Auditor's estimate of the net revenue generated from the Township Fire District Tax Levy, the Village's 55.9 % formula share will be approximately **\$ 77,080.00**

SECTION 3: The Mayor and Village Clerk are authorized to take any steps necessary or appropriate to consummate said contract. Said contract shall be on file in the Village Clerk-Treasurer's Office

SECTION 4: This ordinance is an emergency to allow this legislation to be effective on the contract's February 22, 2019 start date and shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
