Ordinance No. 16-2023

Passed February 6, 2023

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR, WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF THE RURAL COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE PARTNERSHIP (RCAP), TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, AND ENTER INTO A DESIGN/PLANNING LOAN AGREEMENT FOR AN OHIO EPA WATER POLLUTION CONTROL LOAN FUND (WPCLF) LOAN FOR THE LINING AND THE REHABILITATION/INSTALLATION OF TWO (2) MANHOLES IN THE SANITARY SEWER LINE THAT RUNS BETWEEN 5TH AND JEFFERSON AND 4TH STREET AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Brewster desires to proceed with the lining of the sanitary line from 5th and Jefferson to 4th Street and the rehabilitation/construction of two (2) manholes on that sanitary line (Lining and Manhole Project); and

WHEREAS, the Village of Brewster submitted a nomination to Ohio EPA Water Pollution Control Fund (WPCLF) to finance costs of the design/planning of said the lining of the sanitary line from 5th and Jefferson to 4th Street and the rehabilitation/construction of two (2) manholes on that sanitary line (Lining and Manhole Project); and

WHEREAS, the Village of Brewster request for a nomination to Ohio EPA Water Pollution Control Fund (WPCLF) to finance costs of the design/planning of the lining of the sanitary line from 5th and Jefferson to 4th Street and the rehabilitation/construction of two (2) manholes on that sanitary line (Lining and Manhole Project) has been approved; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Brewster desires to follow through and submit/obtain a loan from the Ohio EPA Water Pollution Control Fund (WPCLF) to finance costs of the lining of the sanitary line from 5th and Jefferson to 4th Street and the rehabilitation/construction of two (2) manholes on that sanitary line (Lining and Manhole Project); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Brewster, Ohio:

SECTION 1: Authorize the Village Administrator to employ the services of the Rural Community Assistance Partnership (RCAP) to prepare and submit a loan application to the Ohio EPA Water Pollution Control Fund (WPCLF) to finance the costs of the design/planning of said lining of the sanitary line from 5th and Jefferson to 4th Street and the rehabilitation/construction of two (2) manholes on that sanitary line (Lining and Manhole Project).

SECTION 2: Authorize the Village Administrator to accept grant funds from an Ohio EPA Water Pollution Control Fund (WPCLF) Loan to finance costs of the design/planning of said the lining of the sanitary line from 5th and Jefferson to 4th Street and the rehabilitation/construction of two (2) manholes on that sanitary line (Lining and Manhole Project).

SECTION 3: The Village Administrator and Village Clerk-Treasurer are authorized and directed to execute and take all measures required to accept an Ohio EPA Water Pollution Control Fund (WPCLF) Loan to finance costs of the design/planning of said the lining of the sanitary line from 5th and Jefferson to 4th Street and the rehabilitation/construction of two (2) manholes on that sanitary line (Lining and Manhole Project).

SECTION 4: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of said Village of Brewster for the reason that the lining of the sanitary line from 5th and Jefferson to 4th Street and the rehabilitation/construction of two (2) manholes on that sanitary line (Lining and Manhole Project) is over 80 years old and failure to proceed may require emergency repairs or in the worst case complete replacement at a significantly higher cost, so planning needs to be completed as quickly as possible to allow the bidding and construction of the lining of the sanitary line from 5th and Jefferson to 4th Street and the rehabilitation/construction of two (2) manholes on that sanitary line (Lining and Manhole Project) at the earliest possible time; wherefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage.
