

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMITTING TO THE ELECTORS OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER AT THE GENERAL ELECTION ON NOVEMBER 8, 2016 THE QUESTION OF A TEMPORARY INCREASE IN THE VILLAGE INCOME TAX IN EXCESS OF 1% AT A RATE OF 1 1/2% AND ALLOCATED AND EXPENDED AS FOLLOWS: TWO-TENTHS (0.2) OF ONE PERCENT (1%) SPECIFICALLY DEDICATED TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR THE OPERATION OF THE VILLAGE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND THREE-TENTHS (0.3) OF ONE PERCENT (1%) TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND CONSTRUCTION OF VILLAGE STREETS.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Brewster has determined that it would be in the best interest of the Village to provide a temporary increase in the Village income tax for a five-year period, commencing on January 1, 2017, for a period of five years through December 31, 2021; and

WHEREAS, by virtue of the provisions of 718.04(C)(2) of the Revised Code of Ohio, the approval of the electors of the Village of Brewster is required for any levy on income in excess of 1%.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, OHIO, IN REGULAR SESSION, THAT:

SECTION 1:

That there shall be submitted to the electors of the Village of Brewster, at the general election on November 8, 2016, the question of the approval of the issues under Ordinance # 16-2016 passed by the Council of the Village of Brewster, Ohio on June 6, 2016, providing a temporary increase of a tax on income from 1% to 1 1/2%, and that the said increase is to be allocated and expended as follows: two-tenths (0.2) of one percent (1%) to provide additional funding for the operation of the Village Police Department, and three-tenths (0.3) of one percent (1%) to provide for the funding of the maintenance and construction of Village streets.

Said increase is to be effective from January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2021.

SECTION 2: That it is the desire and request of the Council of the Village of Brewster that ballots for said question shall be substantially in the following form:

A MAJORITY AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF ELECTORS NECESSARY FOR PASSAGE

SHALL THE ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR AN INCREASE IN THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER MUNICIPAL INCOME TAX RATE FROM ONE PERCENT (1.0 %) TO ONE AND ONE- HALF (1.5%) TO BE EFFECTIVE FROM JANUARY 1, 2017 FOR A PERIOD OF FIVE YEARS, FOR THE FOLLOWING PURPOSES: TWO-TENTHS OF ONE PERCENT (0.2%) FOR THE OPERATION OF THE VILLAGE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND THREE-TENTHS OF ONE PERCENT (0.3%) FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND CONSTRUCTION OF VILLAGE STREETS, BE PASSED ?

SECTION 3:

That the Clerk of the Village of Brewster is hereby directed to certify to the Board of Elections of Stark County, Ohio, a copy of Ordinance # 16-2016, upon the enactment of this resolution for the submission of the aforesaid ordinance at the general election to be held on November 8, 2016, and said Clerk is directed to request the aforesaid Board of Elections to provide for the submitting of the question of adopting said ordinance at such election.

SECTION 4: This resolution will become effective on the earliest date provided by law.
