

**A ORDINANCE APPROVING CONTRACT CHANGE ORDER #3 TO KENMORE
CONSTRUCTION FOR THE SWEETWATER PUMP STATION PROJECT**

WHEREAS, Ordinance 13-2014 Brewster Village Council authorized a contract to Kenmore Construction of Akron, Ohio in the amount of \$ 4,182,900 to provide materials and labor to complete Sweetwater Pump Station Project.

WHEREAS, on July 6, 2015 Brewster Village Council adopted Ordinance 20-2015 which authorized Change Order # 1 in the amount of \$ 71,697.98 providing a new contract amount of \$ 4,254,597.98.

WHEREAS, on December 21, 2015 Brewster Village Council adopted Ordinance 50-2015 which authorized Change Order #2 in the amount of \$ 13,706.95 providing a new contract amount of \$ 4,268,304.93.

WHEREAS, additional modifications have been made to the Sweetwater Pump Station Project which necessitates Change Order #3 for additional materials, work, and time.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: Additional work will be performed and additional materials will be supplied by Kenmore Construction in connection with the Contract for the Sweetwater Pump Station Project authorized by Ordinance #13-2014 adopted on February 17, 2014 and modified on July 6, 2015 by Ordinance #20-2015 and on December 21, 2015 by Ordinance #50-2015. The modifications consisted of the installation of bollards around the backup generator per the State Fire Marshall, and the applicable compensation totals \$ 2,439.84.

SECTION 2: The above work will modify the contract cost of \$ 4,268,304.93 authorized by Ordinance 50-2015 Change Order # 2 by an additional \$ 2439.94 making the new contract amount Total = \$ 4,270,744.77

SECTION 3: As in the case of the original contract, the cost of these change orders will be appropriated from and charged to the Sewer Fund.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall be in effect and full force at the earliest date provided by law.
