

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 03-2008 TO PROVIDE A
MODIFICATION TO THE VILLAGE SEWER RATES AND CHARGES**

WHEREAS, Brewster Village Council desires to provide sufficient funding to address the debt incurred for infrastructure upgrades on the Wastewater Treatment facilities and collection system; and

WHEREAS, Brewster Village Council desires to provide sufficient funding to better position the Village for near future costs for additional infrastructure upgrades on the Wastewater Treatment facilities and collection system

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: As outlined in Ordinance 09-1992 it is required that every customer’s water connection be metered, and that the components of each Village Wastewater Treatment customer’s account will be based on that metering. The components of the monthly Billing for those metered accounts shall be increased by 3.5 % beginning with the customer’s bill on January 1st in each of the years listed and are as follows:

SECTION 2: The revenue provided by the above Service Charge will be appropriated to the Sewer Replacement Fund each month. Said funds will be used for maintenance and replacement of sewer utility infrastructure as well as for future debt service, if needed. This ordinance will discontinue that portion of Ordinance 27-2013, Section 2 which directed that four per cent of each month’s sewer collections be placed in the Sewer Replacement Fund

SECTION 3: The revenue provided by the above Capital Charge will be appropriated to the Sewer Debt Fund each month. Said funds will be used to address any debt in the sewer utility. This ordinance will discontinue that portion of Ordinance 28-2013 which directed that \$ 5000.00 of each month’s sewer collections be placed in the Sewer Debt Fund

SECTION 4: As outlined in Ordinance 21-1998 a Sewer Surcharge shall be levied for those users whose sewage has a greater strength than normal domestic sewage, and shall be collected in addition to the normal user charges listed in Section 2. The surcharge is based on a formula from standards provided by the Ohio EPA with Suspended Solids (SS) and Biochemical Oxygen Demand (CBOD) as the measured components. The surcharge for operation, maintenance, and replacement shall be increased by 3.5 % beginning with the customer’s July Usage in each of the years listed and are as follows:

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect beginning with the January 1, 2015 utility billing cycle.
