## A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 19-2014 BY SUSPENDING THE 5% DEPOSIT FROM ELECTRIC UTILITY CUSTOMERS CHARGE

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Brewster created an Electric Improvement Fund to be used for the maintenance and replacement of the Electric Utility infrastructure, and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Clerk-Treasurer was directed and authorized to take all steps necessary or appropriate to deposit five percent (5%) of each month's electric utility customer charge collections into the Electric Improvement Fund, and


**WHEREAS**, the Village of Brewster has determined that the five percent (5%) deposit shall be suspended until otherwise directed and authorized by the Brewster Village Council.

### NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

**SECTION 1:** The Village Clerk-Treasurer is directed and authorized to deposit the full amount of each month's electric utility customer charge collections into the Electric Fund.

**SECTION 2:** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in conformance with applicable open meetings laws and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in compliance with all legal requirements including any applicable open meetings requirements

**SECTION 3:** That this resolution shall take effect with the April 2026 utility payment collections.




