

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT
OF MICHAEL L. MILLER TO THE POSITION OF BREWSTER VILLAGE
ADMINISTRATOR, SETTING HIS COMPENSATION, WAIVING HIS RESIDENCY
REQUIREMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Village Administrator Robert A. Pauley resigned effective on February 24, 2016, and the Village is in need of a Village Administrator, and

WHEREAS, Mayor Michael Schwab desires to appoint Michael L. Miller to the position of Village Administrator, and recommends same to the members of Brewster Village Council, and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code specifies that the appointment of a Village Administrator is with the advice and consent of the Village legislative authority.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: Michael L. Miller shall be appointed to the position of Brewster Village Administrator, and that such appointment shall be in accordance with Section 735.271 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 2: Michael L. Miller as Brewster Village Administrator shall receive compensation in the amount of \$ 62,400.00 annually, and shall receive all benefits afforded a full time employee of the Village.

SECTION 3: In accordance with Section 735.271 of the Ohio Revised Code, Brewster Village Council waives the residency requirement for Village Administrator Michael L. Miller.

SECTION 4: This measure shall be considered under emergency due to the current vacancy in this Village office, and shall be in full force at the earliest time provided by law.
