## AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING INCREASING THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS OF COUNCIL ON THE TREE BOARD FROM TWO (2) TO THREE (3)

WHEREAS, the Brewster Village Council has received a recommendation from the Tree Board to amend Section 91.03 (A) of the Brewster Codified Ordinances to increase the number of members of Village Council on the Tree Board from two (2) to three (3), and

WHEREAS, the increasing the number of members of Village Council on the Tree Board from two (2) to three (3) will create an odd number of total members of the Tree Board, so that a quorum becomes three (3) members, and


WHEREAS, the increasing the number of members of Village Council on the Tree Board from two (2) to three (3) will create an odd number of total members of the Tree Board, so that there is less chance of a tie vote, and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:**

**SECTION 1:** the Brewster Village Council hereby increases the number of members of Village Council on the Tree Board from two (2) to three (3), so that Section (A) of 91.03 reads:


There is hereby created and established a Tree Board for the village, which shall be three (3) members of Village Council, who shall be appointed by the Mayor with the approval of Village Council, the Mayor, and the Village Administrator. The Council members of the Tree Board will be appointed on January 1 of each year.

**SECTION 2:** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
