AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO MAKE PREPARATION FOR AND TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR A BUILDING TO HOUSE ITS DIGGER/DERRICK TRUCK AND THE REST/ENTIRETY OF THE EKLECTRIC DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Electric Department taken delivery of a Digger/Derrick Truck, which is too large to fit into the building the current smaller Digger/Derrick Truck is currently stored in, and

WHEREAS, due to both the cost of the Digger/Derrick Truck at \$275,000 and its hydraulics, the new Digger/Derrick Truck should be stored in a structure, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Brewster Council authorized the Village Administrator to enter into contract with Engineering Associates for the design of and preparation of bid specifications and the required Bid Documents for a building to house the Digger/Derrick Truck and the rest/entirety of the Electric Department, including equipment; and

WHEREAS, the specifications will be completed in the near future for a a building to house the Digger/Derrick Truck and the rest/entirety of the Electric Department, including equipment, by Engineering Associates


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: Village Council authorizes the Village Administrator to take the following steps to prepare for and bid a building to house the Digger/Derrick Truck and the rest/entirety of the Electric Department, including equipment:

- A. Competitively Bid for a building to house the Digger/Derrick Truck and the rest/entirety of the Electric Department, including equipment, in accordance with all State of Ohio laws, all Village of Brewster ordinances.
- B. Based on the received Bids, shall work with Engineering Associates, the Electric Superintendent, and the Mayor to provide Council with a recommended Contractor for consideration for awarding a contract for a building to house the Digger/Derrick Truck and the rest/entirety of the Electric Department, including equipment, via ordinance as prescribed by State Law.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is deemed an emergency due to the need to provide for a new structure for the Electric Department's Digger/Derrick Truck due to the fact that construction season after the process of bidding and entering into a contract would otherwise be lengthened to the point of increasing costs, and therefor time is of the essence.




