

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A GOVERNMENTAL GAS AGGREGATION
PROGRAM AGREEMENT WITH VOUNTEER ENERGY SERVICES, INC.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to its consulting agreement with the Village of Brewster, Buckeye Energy Brokers has recommended that the Village accept the bid of Volunteer Energy Services, Inc. for the provision of natural gas pursuant to the Village's gas aggregation program; and

WHEREAS, after review Council finds that the bid of Volunteer Energy Services, Inc. was obtained through an appropriate competitive bidding process; that it is the lowest and best bid received; and that it would be in the best interest of the Village of Brewster to enter into said agreement; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into the proposed agreement with Volunteer Energy Services, Inc. for the provision of natural gas pursuant to the Village's gas aggregation program for a two-year term to run from October 1, 2016 through September 30, 2018

SECTION 2: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
