Resolution No. 29-2022 Passed May 2, 2022

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A WRITTEN PROCUREMENT POLICIES AND PROCEDURES POLICY FOR THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT OF 2021 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2021, the American Rescue Plan Act (“ARPA”) was signed into law effective May 17, 2021. Section 9901 of ARPA amended Title VI of the Social Security Act 17 (the Act) to add section 602, which established the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund, and section 603, which established the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund (together, the “Funds”). The Funds are intended to provide support to State, local, and Tribal governments (together, recipients) in responding to the impact of COVID-19 and in their efforts to contain COVID-19 on their communities, residents, and businesses; and

WHEREAS, Section 603(c)(1)(C) of ARPA allows use of the Funds for the provision of government services to the extent of the reduction in revenue of such *** non-entitlement unit of local government entities due to the COVID-19 public health emergency relative to revenues collected in the most recent full fiscal year of the non-entitlement unit of local government to the emergency; and

WHEREAS, the US Treasury has adopted various rules attached to the use of the Funds, having issued a Final Rule on January 6, 2022, effective April 1, 2022; and


WHEREAS, the US Treasury requires that expenditures must follow written procurement policies and procedures that follow Federal Laws/Regulations and Uniform Guidance and ARPA-specific award terms as illustrated in Exhibit A.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: The Village Clerk-Treasurer is hereby directed to follow the written procurement policies and procedures in the use of APRA funds.


SECTION 2: The Village -Clerk Treasurer shall report use of funds to Treasury by April 30, 2022 and annually thereafter until all funds are expended.


