Ordinance No. 29-2026

Passed March 16, 2026

AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE ALLOCATION OF VARIOUS SALARIES/WAGES AND SUPERCEDING ANY RELATED ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, there are various preceding ordinances that allocate salaries/wages among various funds for the salaries/wages of:

- the Mayor, and
- Council, and
- Clerk-Treasurer, and
- Administrator, and
- Clerk's Office personnel, and
- Utility Office personnel, and,

WHEREAS, Brewster Village desires to amend any preceding ordinances that allocate salaries/wages among various funds for the salaries/wages for the forgoing positions and/or Departments; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: Effective on January 1, 2026 the annual salaries of the following positions and/or Departments shall be allocated as follows:


| | General Fund | Electric Fund | Water Fund | Sewer Fund |
|--------------------------|--------------|---------------|------------|------------|
| Mayor | 50% | 17% | 16% | 16% |
| Councilmembers | 50% | 17% | 16% | 16% |
| Clerk-Treasurer | 50% | 17% | 16% | 16% |
| Administrator | 50% | 17% | 16% | 16% |
| Clerk's Office Personnel | 50% | 17% | 16% | 16% |
| Utility Office Personnel | 0% | 40% | 30% | 30% |

SECTION 2: Expenses (materials and supplies) for the foregoing positions/departments shall be allocated based on the same percentages.


SECTION 3: The above allocations replace any previous/current allocations established by ordinance(s) and supersede any previous/current allocations, formal or informal, written or unwritten, which may be in conflict with this ordinance.

SECTION 4: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in conformance with applicable open meetings laws and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in compliance with all legal requirements including any applicable open meetings requirements

SECTION 5: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
