## AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE AWARDING OF A CONTRACT FOR THE BREWSTER SANITARY SEWER LINING AND MANHOLES PROJECT

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Brewster desires to proceed with the lining of the sanitary line from 5th and Jefferson to 4th Street and the rehabilitation/construction of two (2) manholes on that sanitary line (Lining and Manholes Project); and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Brewster submitted a nomination to Ohio EPA Water Pollution Control Fund (WPCLF) to finance costs of the construction of said Lining and Manholes Project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Brewster's request for a WPCLF Loan to finance costs of the construction of the Lining and Manholes Project has been approved; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Brewster has advertised and received bids for the Lining and Manholes Project; and

**WHEREAS**, Council finds that the bid of **Insight Pipe Contracting** of **Harmony, Pennsylvania** in the amount of **\$152,425** was the lowest and best bidder for the Lining and Manholes Project.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:**

**SECTION 1:** Brewster Village Council awards a contract to **Insight Pipe Contracting** of **Harmony, Pennsylvania** for the Lining and Manholes Project in accordance with the Village specifications on which the bids were received for a contract price of **\$152,425**, with the final amount to be determined based on actual quantities and bid prices.


**SECTION 2:** The Village Administrator and Village Clerk-Treasurer are authorized and directed to execute the contract **with Insight Pipe Contracting** of **Harmony, Pennsylvania** for the completion of the Lining and Manholes Project in accordance with the specifications on which the Bids were received. An executed copy of the Contract shall be kept on file in the Village Clerk-Treasurer's Office.

**SECTION 3:** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.




