A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE FAIRLESS LOCAL SCHOOLS SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOLS PLAN

WHEREAS, the Village of Brewster Council authorized an application for a transportation planning grant from the Stark County Regional Planning Commission (SCRPC) through the Stark County Area Transportation Study (SCATS) by Resolution 32-2024 to update the Village's and Fairless Local Schools Safe Routes to Schools Travel Plan adopted in 2018, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Brewster was awarded a transportation planning grant from the SCRPC through SCATS to update the Village's and Fairless Local Schools Safe Routes to Schools Travel Plan adopted in 2018, which the Village of Brewster Council accepted by Resolution 65-2024, and

WHEREAS, GPD was selected by the SCRPC through SCATS to update the Village's and Fairless Local Schools Safe Routes to Schools Travel Plan adopted in 2018, and

WHEREAS, GPD formed a team of individuals from the Village and Fairless Local Schools to assist in completing an update of the Village's and Fairless Local Schools Safe Routes to Schools Travel Plan adopted in 2018, and

WHEREAS, the Village, Administrators, and parents of students at Fairless Local Schools joined together to improve safety and encourage more students to walk and bicycle to school, and

WHEREAS, by implementing an updated Safe Routes to School Travel Plan in Fairless Local Schools, the goals are to:

- Educate and encourage K-8 students to walk and bicycle to school.
- Increase the ability for children to walk and bike to school by eliminating physical barriers
- Make walking and bicycling routes safer for students who are already walking
- Improve students' physical activity and health
- Improve air quality and reduce traffic congestion around the school
- Create a walkable and bikeable community by installing bike/walking paths that allow safer travel and more connectivity between the school campuses, downtown Brewster, area residents, and future bike trails, and


WHEREAS, a final Safe Routes to School Travel Plan in Fairless Local Schools plan has been completed by GPD.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER THAT:

SECTION 1: Brewster Village Council is fully supportive of Fairless Local School's Safe Routes to School Travel Plan and program, and pledges to support the efforts and provide resources as appropriate.

SECTION 2: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in conformance with applicable open meetings laws and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in compliance with all legal requirements including any applicable open meetings requirements

SECTION 3: This resolution shall take effect at the earliest date provided by law.
