

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF KEITH M. CRETER  
TO THE POSITION OF BREWSTER VILLAGE POLICE CHIEF,  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Village Police Chief Harry Porter retired effective on August 15, 2016, and the Village is in need of a Village Police Chief, and

WHEREAS, Mayor Michael Schwab desires to appoint current Village Police Captain Keith M. Creter to the position of Village Police Chief, and recommends same to the members of Brewster Village Council, and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code specifies that the appointment of a Village Police Chief is with the advice and consent of the Village legislative authority.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:**

**SECTION 1:** Keith M. Creter shall be appointed to the position of Brewster Village Police Chief, and that such appointment shall be in accordance with Sections 737.15 and 737.17, as well as any other applicable portions of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 2:** This measure shall be considered under emergency due to the current vacancy in this Village office, and shall be in full force at the earliest time provided by law.
