A RESOLUTION TO REOPEN VILLAGE BALLFIELDS IN THE VILLAGE PARK WITH CONDITIONS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Whereas, the Governor of Ohio has issued an order for the reopening of certain businesses and activities with exceptions as part of his restart Ohio program.

Whereas, the Governor has allowed the opening of adult/minor baseball and softball programs and activities with certain conditions issued by the Ohio Director of Health which are set forth in a poster issued by the Department.

Whereas, as in all cases of the Governor's orders the enforcement of said orders are the responsibility of local governments and the local department of Health.

Whereas, the Village of Brewster deems it necessary and proper to open the Village ballfields at the Village Park for sports activity consistent with the Director of Health's directives and subject to further conditions:

Therefore, be it RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Brewster, Ohio, that

Section 1. The ballfields at the Village Park be opened effective upon the Local Department of Health's approval of the facilities as in compliance with health regulations and subject to the following conditions:

Section 2. The Poster containing directives issued by the Director of Health be enlarged and placed in a conspicuous position at the entrance of the fields or affixed to cages and back stops so the rules of behavior will be in plain sight of all who attend and/or participate in the activity. The poster shall contain contact information for the Village Police and Local Department of Health so that violations may be reported.

Section 3. The coach/manager or other responsible party who is in charge of conducting and participating in the activity sign an acknowledgement form that he/she has read and understands the health order directives, and has communicated these to the participants and spectators prior to the commencement of the activities. In addition, the party shall be responsible to monitor compliance and report any violations to the Police Chief, or Local Department of Health. Copies of the poster shall be made available for distribution to all parties who participate in the activity including spectators.


Section 4. The Mayor is authorized to modify or add additional requirements to enforce the Health Director's orders, and to close the ballparks if deemed necessary due to a failure of compliance with health orders.

Section 5. This resolution shall remain in effect for as long as Health Department orders are in effect.

Section 6. This resolution is declared an emergency so that the fields may be opened as soon as possible, and so that the opening can coincide with the Governor's orders regarding Covid-19 allowing the sports activity to take place with conditions, and for the health, safety and welfare of the Village of Brewster.
