A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE STARK COUNTY REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION FOR A SCATS COMMUNITY TRANSPORTATION PLANNING GRANT, AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Stark County Regional Planning Commission (SCRPC) through the Stark County Area Transportation Study (SCATS) Program is making available Community Transportation Planning Grants to encourage effective planning and to improve multi-model transportation throughout Stark County; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Brewster previously applied for and received Stark County Area Transportation Study (SCATS) Program is making available Community Transportation Planning Grant to develop its Safe Routes to Schools Plan pursuant to Ordinance 74-2017, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that grant, a Safe Routes to Schools Travel Plan was developed and adopted by the Village and Fairless Local Schools in November 2018, and

WHEREAS, since its adoption numerous tasks listed in the Safe Routes to Schools Travel Plan have been completed, including a Safe Routes to Schools Shared Use Path between the Middle School and Elementary School with a Safe Routes to Schools Grant of \$336,000, and

WHEREAS, in order to apply for future Safe Routes to Schools grants, the Safe Routes to Schools Travel Plan that was developed and adopted by the Village and Fairless Local Schools in November 2018 must be updated, and

WHEREAS, Council is still interested in completing a Safe Routes to Schools Path that includes connecting Brewster Downtown to Fairless Schools, which has been started, and which as Council found in 2017 would entail multifaceted projects involving the ODOT Safe Routes to Schools program to provide a path for students to safely walk to Fairless Schools, as well as our residents, and to integrate a conceptual trail envisioned by Stark County Parks from Navarre to Brewster.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: That the Brewster Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to file an application with the Stark County Regional Planning Commission (SCRPC) through the Stark County Area Transportation Study (SCATS) Program for a Community Transportation Planning Grant and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible financial assistance. In addition, the Village Administrator is authorized to execute any contracts applicable to the grant.

SECTION 2: That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized to employ an engineering firm to prepare basic drawings, plans, and cost estimates in preparation for this proposed grant and for the submittal of the required documents for a Community Transportation Planning Grant funding application.

SECTION 3. That Brewster Village Council does agree to obligate the Village for matching funds of 10% of the costs, up to \$ 2500, for the Village portion of the Community Transportation Planning study.
