

**AN ORDINANCE AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR CASUALTY AND LIABILITY INSURANCE TO WICHERT INSURANCE**

WHEREAS, in accordance with applicable law, quotes were requested and accepted to provide casualty and liability insurance for the Village of Brewster for a one-year period commencing with September 25, 2016 and ending on September 24, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the quote from Wichert Insurance was the lowest and best quote received; and

WHEREAS, the policy specifications and contract from Wichert Insurance for a one-year period commencing with September 25, 2016 and ending on September 24, 2017

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

**SECTION 1:** The Mayor and Clerk are authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the Wichert Insurance for casualty and liability insurance for the Village for a total policy premium from Selective Insurance in year one of \$ 46,718.00 and runs from September 25, 2016 through September 24, 2017. This contract is in accordance with the proposal submitted by the Wichert Insurance on September 6, 2016.

**SECTION 2:** The Mayor and Clerk are authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the Wichert Insurance for Crime/Cyber insurance for the Village for a total policy premium from Travelers Insurance in year one of \$ 4,946.00.00 and runs from September 25, 2016 through September 24, 2017. This contract is in accordance with the proposal submitted by the Wichert Insurance on September 6, 2016.

**SECTION 3.** The funds necessary for payment of said premium are appropriated from the General, Electric, Sewer, and Water Funds. Each of these four funds will pay an equal share of 25% of the total cost.

**SECTION 4:** This shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
