The following is Resolution enacted by the Village of Brewster and the Fairless Local Schools Board of Education, of Stark County, Ohio, hereinafter referred to as the Applicant, in the matter of the stated described project.

**WHEREAS**, the United States Congress has set aside monies for Safe Routes to School Projects through the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation; and

**WHEREAS**, Applicants can apply for these monies and be selected for funding by the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation; and

**WHEREAS**, implementation of a School Travel Plan is an activity eligible to receive federal transportation funding.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Village of Brewster and the Fairless Local Schools Board of Education, State of Ohio, that:

**SECTION ONE:** The Village Administrator of the Village of Brewster is hereby empowered on behalf of the Applicant to prepare and execute an application for SRTS funding to implement the School Travel Plan Development already adopted by the entities and to submit same to the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation.

**SECTION TWO:** If awarded the funding, the Village of Brewster further agrees to pay One Hundred Percent (100%) of the cost over and above the funding provided for the Safe Routes to School Project, as set forth in its application, through the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation.

**SECTION THREE:** If the application is approved for the Safe Routes to School funding for the Village of Brewster, the applicant is hereby empowered on behalf of the LPA to enter into a contract with the Director of the Ohio Department of Transportation necessary to complete the above described project.

**SECTION FOUR:** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
