AN ORDINANCE THAT AUTHORIZES THE PURCHASE OF TWO 2020 CHEVROLET TAHOE POLICE PURSUIT VEHICLES AND NECESSARY EQUIPMENT FROM GANLEY CHEVROLET FOR THE VILLAGE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Brewster Village Council hereby declares that it is in the best interest of the Village of Brewster to purchase two new Police vehicles and necessary equipment; and

WHEREAS, Brewster Village Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the Village to purchase two (2) 2020 Chevrolet Tahoe Police Pursuit Vehicles and necessary equipment from Ganley Chevrolet of Aurora, Ohio the State Bidder holder under the Ohio Department of Administrative Services' Cooperative Purchasing Program and as provided under Ohio Revised Code Section 125.04 and Section 731.14.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: The Village Administrator and Village Clerk are authorized to take all steps necessary to enter into a contract for the purchase of two (2) 2020 Chevrolet Tahoe 4WD Police Pursuit Vehicles and necessary equipment from Ganley Chevrolet of Aurora, Ohio at a contract price that shall not exceed \$ 100,000. Said contract for the two 2020 Chevrolet Tahoe 4WD Police Pursuit Vehicles and equipment will be in accordance with State specifications.

SECTION 2: Funds for the purchase of the two 2020 Chevrolet Tahoe 4WD Police Pursuit Vehicles and necessary equipment shall be appropriated from the Village Police Income Tax Fund as directed by Council.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be deemed an emergency as both SRO vehicles are in need of extensive repairs and the opportunity to purchase vehicles to replace them given current market conditions may preclude the purchase of new vehicles fully equipped in the near future due to unavailability and for the safety of the Officers and shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.


