

**AN ORDINANCE ALLOCATING FUNDS FOR THE
EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES FUND**

WHEREAS, Brewster Village Council desires to provide additional moneys for the funding of
Emergency Medical Services; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: The cost of dispatching ambulances shall be paid from the Fire Fund.

SECTION 2: \$ 15,000 received from the 4 mil Fire Levy approved at the November 2015 Ballot shall
be allocated to the Emergency Medical Services Fund

SECTION 3: Section 2 of Ordinance 39-2013 which created the Ambulance Replacement Fund and
that allocated 17.5% of any revenue received from EMS Runs collections shall be modified to state:
The source of revenue deposited into the Ambulance Replacement Fund shall be five per cent
(5.0 %) of each month's Emergency Medical Service (EMS) Run collections, and said funds shall be
used solely for the replacement of an ambulance.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
