

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER TO PETITION THE STARK COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO ANNEX PARCEL #10010433 INTO THE VILLAGE

WHEREAS, with the completion of a Solar Field Project with NextEra and AMPPartners, the Village of Brewster came into the possession and ownership of property designated by Stark County as Parcel #10010433 and is further described in a deed recorded at Imaging Number 201806190024002 of the Stark County Records, and is located in Sugar Creek Township contiguous to the Brewster corporation limits, and

WHEREAS, Brewster Village Council desires to annex Parcel #10010433 into the Village of Brewster to provide Police and other municipal services to the property, and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Chapter 709.16 provides that a municipal corporation may petition the Board of County Commissioners to annex contiguous property owned only by the municipal corporation, and

WHEREAS, Brewster Village Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the Village of Brewster to proceed with said Annexation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: Brewster Village Council authorizes that a petition be filed with the Board of County Commissioners to provide for the annexation of property into the Village of property located in Sugar Creek Township that is contiguous with the Brewster corporation limits, and is designated as Parcel #10010433 by Stark County, and further described in Imaging Number 201806190024002 of the Stark County Records.

SECTION 2: The Village Administrator and the Village Solicitor are authorized and directed to file the petition and to prosecute the proceedings to complete the annexation of Parcel #10010433 into the Village of Brewster.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
