

**AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE COMPENSATION FOR THE  
VILLAGE CLERK-TREASURER EFFECTIVE ON APRIL 1, 2020**

WHEREAS, Ordinance 21-2015, last addressed the compensation for Village Clerk-Treasurer; and

WHEREAS, Brewster Village Council desires to amend Ordinances 21-2015 to modify the compensation provided to the Village Clerk-Treasurer, and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 733.261 describes the duties and assignment of compensation of the Village Clerk-Treasurer and Ohio Revised Code Section 731.07 outlines the restrictions on modifying any compensation for this elected position, and

WHEREAS, the duties provided by Ordinance 38-1989 for the Village Clerk-Treasurer to be the Deputy Income Tax Commissioner, as well as the duties and compensation assigned under Ordinance 44-2000 for the Village Clerk-Treasurer to attend Village Council Meetings will be included in the duties and compensation of the Village Clerk-Treasurer.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER THAT:

**SECTION 1:**

A. Effective with the Village Clerk-Treasurer’s term that begins on April 1, 2020 compensation for all duties assigned under the Ohio Revised Code and by Village statute for the Village Clerk-Treasurer the annual salary of the Village Clerk Treasurer shall be adjusted annually on an incremental basis in the following manner:

	April 1, 2020	April 1, 2021	April 1, 2022	April 1, 2023
Village Clerk-Treasurer	\$ 40,824.00	\$ 42,048.72	\$ 42,889.69	\$ 43,747.49

B. As outlined in Ordinance 21-2014 the salary shall be divided between four Village funds at the percentages as listed next:

General Fund = 50%	Electric Fund = 30%
Water Fund = 10%	Sewer Fund = 10%

**SECTION 2:** Section 1B of Ordinance 21-2015 shall be repealed and the Village Clerk shall not be eligible for any medical waiver.

**SECTION 3:** This ordinance shall be in effect at the earliest date provided by law.
