Resolution No. 39-2021 Passed August 16th, 2021

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR A TUSCARAWAS-LOCUSTDALE-PINEWOOD WATER LINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT, AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program provides financial assistance to local subdivisions for capital improvements for public infrastructure, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Brewster is planning to make needed water line replacements on Tuscarawas from Locustdale to Chestnut, Locustdale from Tuscarawas to Wabash, and Pinewood from Tuscarawas to Wabash in the Village, and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority for the community because of their age and a recent EPA review of Village water system that stated that all 4-inch lines should be upgraded to 6-inch to comply with Ten States Standards Section 8.2.2, which states that a minimum waterline size of six inches shall be provided for water mains that provide fire protection, and

WHEREAS, the Tuscarawas-Locustdale-Pinewood Water Line Replacement Project is qualified under the OPWC programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: That the Brewster Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to file an application with the Ohio Public Works Commission for the Tuscarawas-Locustdale-Pinewood Water Line Replacement Project and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible financial assistance. In addition, the Village Administrator is authorized to execute any contracts applicable to the grant.

SECTION 2: That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized to employ an engineering firm to prepare basic drawings, plans, and cost estimates in preparation for this proposed grant and for the submittal of the required documents for the OPWC funding application.

SECTION 3: That Brewster Village Council does agree to obligate the Village funds to the extent necessary for obtaining the proposed grant.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.




