**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 78 (PARKING SCHEDULES), SECTION III (COMMERCIAL VEHICLES) (B)(2) OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER TRAFFIC CODE PROHIBITING PARKING BY DESIGNATED VEHICLES ON THE STREETS OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER**

**WHEREAS** the Village of Brewster desires to amend Chapter 78 Section III Commercial Vehicles (B)(2) of the Village Traffic code to allow limited permission for loading and unloading of vehicles while parked on Village streets.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, OHIO, THAT:**

**SECTION 1:** Chapter 78 (Parking Schedules) Section III (Commercial Vehicles) (B)(2) of the codified ordinances of the Village of Brewster prohibiting parking on Village Streets by the vehicles designated therein shall be amended to allow limited permission for loading and unloading, and shall read in total after the amendment as follows:

Chapter 78 (Parking Schedules) Section III (Commercial Vehicles) (B)(2) No person shall park a recreational vehicle, mobile home or manufactured home, motor home, camper, trailer, watercraft or boat trailer upon any street within the Village except for the limited purpose of loading or unloading for no more than twenty-four hours, and such person shall not obstruct the flow of traffic in the street during the loading or unloading of the vehicle.

**SECTION 2:** This amendment shall not affect the penalty under this section.

**SECTION 3:** All prior ordinances pertaining to the subjects treated in this ordinance shall be deemed repealed from and after the effective date of this ordinance, except as they are included and reordained in whole or in part in this ordinance, and any such repeal shall not affect any offense committed or penalty incurred, or any right established prior to the effective date of this ordinance.


**SECTION 4:** This action was taken by Council in an open meeting held in compliance with Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22 et. seq.


