

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH WORKPLACE SERVICES CORPORATION
D/B/A LIFESERVICES EAP TO PROVIDE VILLAGE EMPLOYEE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM
SERVICES AS WELL AS RELATED SERVICES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Brewster Village Council desires to provide an employee assistance program for the employees of the Village of Brewster; and

WHEREAS, an agreement has been submitted by Workplace Services Corporation d/b/a Life Services EAP to provide employee assistance program services for employees of the Village of Brewster; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that it would be in the best interest of the Village of Brewster to enter into the agreement as submitted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: The Village Administrator and Clerk-Treasurer are authorized to enter into an agreement with Workplace Services Corporation d/b/a Life Services EAP to provide employee assistance program services for employees of the Village of Brewster as outlined in the agreement submitted by Workplace Services Corporation d/b/a Life Services EAP to the Village on May 30, 2019. Said agreement is on file in the Village Clerk-Treasurer's Office.

SECTION 2: The payments due under this agreement shall be appropriated from and charged to each of the Village departments in a manner applicable to the number of employees eligible for the employee assistance services.

SECTION 3: This ordinance is an emergency to provide the benefits of this program to Village employees in a timely manner and shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
