A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR A CHESTNUT WIDENING AND RESURFACING PROJECT, AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED

WHEREAS, the Ohio Public Works Commission Capital Improvement Program provides financial assistance to local subdivisions for capital improvements for public infrastructure, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Brewster is planning to make needed capital improvements for a project entitled the Chestnut Widening and Resurfacing Project, which is to add berms to a portion, mill a portion, and resurfacing Chestnut from the west side of the entrance to Spidell Funeral Home on Chestnut, then proceeding approximately 1473 feet west to just west of the driveway of 13171 Chestnut in the Village, and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority for the community and is qualified under the OPWC programs, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: That the Brewster Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to file an application with the Ohio Public Works Commission for the Chestnut Widening and Resurfacing Project and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible financial assistance. In addition, the Village Administrator is authorized to execute any contracts applicable to the grant.

SECTION 2: That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized to employ an engineering firm to prepare basic drawings, plans, and cost estimates in preparation for this proposed grant and/or loan and for the submittal of the required documents for the OPWC funding application.


SECTION 3: That Brewster Village Council does agree to obligate the Village funds to the extent necessary for obtaining the proposed grant.

SECTION 4: The legislation authorizing the Chestnut Widening and Resurfacing Project to be submitted for an OPWC Grant/Loan is being passed on an emergency basis as the deadline for OPWC Applications for District 19 is October 11th, 2024.


