A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM FOR A JEFFERSON AVENUE SANITARY SEWER PROJECT, AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED

WHEREAS, the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program under the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development provides financial assistance to local subdivisions for capital improvements for public infrastructure, and

WHEREAS, the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program in Stark County is administered by the Stark County Regional Planning Commission on behalf of the Board of Stark County Commissioners to benefit low- to moderate-income and homeless persons and families throughout Stark County, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Brewster is planning to make needed capital improvements to the Jefferson Avenue Sanitary Sewer Line in the Village through a Jefferson Avenue Sanitary Sewer Project, and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority for the community and is qualified under the CDBG program to benefit low- to moderate-income and homeless persons and families in Brewster.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: That the Brewster Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to file an application with the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible financial assistance. In addition, the Village Administrator is authorized to execute any contracts applicable to the grant.

SECTION 2: That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized to employ an engineering firm to prepare basic drawings, plans, and cost estimates in preparation for this proposed grant and for the submittal of the required documents for the OPWC funding application.

SECTION 3. That Brewster Village Council does agree to obligate the Village funds to the extent necessary for obtaining the proposed grant.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
