AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH FAIRLESS LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR THE VILLAGE TO PROVIDE SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICERS FROM THE BREWSTER POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR THE 2023-2024 SCHOOL YEAR

WHEREAS, in 2018 Fairless Local School District requested two School Resource Officers (SRO) from the Brewster Police Department for the 2018-2019 School Year; and

WHEREAS, Fairless Local School District desires to continue utilizing School Resource Officers (SRO) from the Brewster Police Department in Fairless Schools for the 2023 - 2024 School Year; and

WHEREAS, Brewster Village Council desires to provide School Resource Officers from the Brewster Police Department to be assigned to Fairless Schools for the 2023 - 2024 School Year.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: The Village shall enter into a Memorandum of Understanding Agreement with the Fairless Local School District to provide School Resource Officer services for the 2023 - 2024 School Year. Said agreement will be reviewed at the close of the 2023 - 2024 in June of 2024 and renewed if appropriate.

SECTION 2: Services and payments shall be as provided in this Memorandum of Understanding Agreement between the Fairless Local School District and the Village that will be on file at Village Hall.


SECTION 3: The Mayor and the Village Police Chief are authorized to take any steps necessary or appropriate to consummate said agreement.


