AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 55-2022 THAT ADJUSTED THE COMPENSATION OF VILLAGE EMPLOYEES FOR 2023 THROUGH 2025

WHEREAS, the Employee Compensation Committee as originally established in Ordinance 93-2017, and continued in Ordinance 66-2020, Ordinance 80-2020, Ordinance 59-2021, and Ordinance 55-2022, was comprised of the Village Clerk-Treasurer, the Village Administrator, the Chair of Brewster Council's Finance Committee, and the Mayor, and

WHEREAS, Section 6 of Ordinance 55-2022 currently reads:

Employee Compensation Committee

Annually, unless a multi-year wage ordinance adopted by Council, the Employee Compensation Committee consisting of the Village Clerk-Treasurer, the Village Administrator, the Chair of Brewster Council's Finance Committee, and the Mayor will review any pending or proposed compensation of the Village Full Time and Part Time employees for the following Year's Budget in each department. The Employee Compensation Committee will begin their review no later than May 15th each year and shall provide Brewster Council with a recommendation no later than September 30th each year.

WHEREAS, Brewster Village Council desires to amend Ordinance 55-2022 to modify the composition of the Employee Compensation Committee set forth in Section 6.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT SECTION 6 OF ORDINANCE 55-2022 BE AMNEDED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 6: Employee Compensation Committee

Annually, unless a multi-year wage ordinance adopted by Council, the Employee Compensation Committee consisting of the Village Clerk-Treasurer, the Village Administrator, the Chair of Brewster Council's Finance Committee, Council Member Brett Long, and the Mayor will review any pending or proposed compensation of the Village Full Time and Part Time employees for the following Year's Budget in each department. The Employee Compensation Committee will begin their review no later than May 15th each year and shall provide Brewster Council with a recommendation no later than September 30th each year.


Effective Date

This ordinance shall be effective at the earliest date allowed by law.




