

Minutes
Council of the Whole Meeting
April 15, 2024 - 5:45 PM

Attendance: Mayor Hawk, VA Miller, Clerk – Treas. Kris King, Council Members Dorkoff, Godwin, Hilliard, Long, and Radich.

The meeting was held in the yard waste center on First Street behind the police station. The meeting was opened by Mayor Hawk and turned over to VA Miller.

VA Miller walked off the area that was going to be fenced in. There will be an entrance on the west side of the facility with a key card for the residents to enter. This year there will be no fee for the key cards. We will evaluate the cost over the next year to determine if residents need to contribute to the cost of the facility. On the east side of the facility, there will be a sensor that will open the gate to allow residents to leave the area. The entrance gate will be 24 feet wide to allow the trucks to switch out the dumpsters. The area where the dumpsters will be put will not be paved because of the weight of the dumpsters and the trucks moving them in and out of the facility, but we may put some street grindings down to build the area up and reduce the amount of mud. VA Miller estimates that there will only be one third of the current waste once it is only for residents.

There will be cameras in the area and if residents pass out their cards to other people, their right to use the facility will be revoked.

VA Miller has received one quote for the project and is expecting a second quote soon. He wants to get the project started as soon as possible to reduce the cost.
