

**AN ORDINANCE EMPLOYING ATTORNEY JOHN F. ANTHONY AS  
VILLAGE SOLICITOR FOR A TWO YEAR PERIOD COMMENCING  
ON JANUARY 1, 2017, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village Council of Brewster has deemed it necessary for health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Brewster to contract for a Village Solicitor.

WHEREAS, Attorney John F. Anthony has agreed to serve as the Brewster Village Solicitor, and Village Council desires to retain his services on the terms and conditions hereafter set forth.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER THAT:**

**SECTION 1:** Attorney John Anthony shall be contracted for the position of Village Solicitor for a two year period beginning January 1, 2017 and ending December 31, 2018 at a rate of Sixteen Thousand Dollars (\$ 16,000.00) per annum. In addition, said salary paid by the Village shall be subject to PERS contribution. This agreement may be terminated by either party by giving sixty (60) days notice.

**SECTION 2:** The Village Solicitor shall be authorized to employ other attorneys as may be needed from time to time upon the occasion that in his discretion he would have a conflict of interest or that he is not capable of a specialized area of law, with Village Council's approval.

**SECTION 3:** The Village Solicitor shall be a part-time position and has approval of the Village to work and receive compensation in other positions both public and private.

**SECTION 4:** The Village Solicitor shall be paid the rate set out in Section One (1) of this ordinance for attending regular meetings no more than twice per month and for all usual and necessary duties of said position at the regular meetings including but not limited to preparation of legislation, and advice and counsel for all Village departments.

**SECTION 5:** The Village Solicitor shall be entitled to compensation at the rate of One Hundred Seventy-Five Dollars and No Cents (\$175.00) per hour for extraordinary services, with said services to be approved by Council prior to their performance, and at the rate of \$ 200.00 per meeting session for any additional sessions beyond the two meetings mentioned in Section 4, whether regular or special meetings.

**SECTION 4:** This Ordinance shall be considered as an emergency to allow the contract to be in effect on January 1, 2017 and shall take effect at the earliest date provided by law.
