

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO PREPARE AND  
SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION STATE  
CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR A VILLAGE SEVENTH STREET  
IMPROVEMENT AND PAVING PROJECT, AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED**

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program provides financial assistance to local subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Brewster is planning to make capital improvements to Seventh Street in the Village through a Village Seventh Street Improvement and Paving Project, and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority for the community and is qualified under the OPWC programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: That the Brewster Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to file an application with the Ohio Public Works Commission and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible financial assistance. In addition, the Village Administrator is authorized to execute any contracts applicable to the grant.

SECTION 2: That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized to employ an engineering firm to prepare basic drawings, plans, and cost estimates in preparation for this proposed grant and for the submittal of the required documents for the OPWC funding application.

SECTION 3. That Brewster Village Council does agree to obligate the Village funds to the extent necessary for obtaining the proposed grant.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
