

**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO RURAL
COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (RCAP) FOR COOPERATIVE
GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION SYSTEM (GIS) SERVICES**

WHEREAS, Village Council desires to provide Village utilities, street, and other Village operations with the advantages of a Geographic Information System to maintain and enhance mapping and information capabilities in those Village operations; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Rural Community Assistance Program completed Global Positioning System (GPS) mapping and information data collecting in the Village Water, Sewer, and Electric utilities; and

WHEREAS, Village Council desires provide all Village operations with the ability to maintain and update the Village GIS and GPS capabilities through a professional service

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1:

The Village Administrator is authorized to enter into the agreement submitted by the Ohio Rural Community Assistance Program (RCAP) agency for GIS services on October 5, 2016. This agreement is for a term beginning on January 1, 2017 and ending on December 31, 2021. Said agreement shall be kept on file in the Village Clerk's Office

SECTION 2:

Taken from Exhibit B of the Agreement the GIS Cooperative Service Agreement Participant Fee Schedule is as follows:

1. \$150 base fee per quarter. This may be waived for communities under 2,000 in population depending upon the availability of special grant funding.
2. \$0.41 per water customer per quarter for the first 4,000 customers, after which the charge will be reduced by 50%
3. \$0.31 per sanitary sewer customer per quarter for the first 4,000 customers, after which the charge will be reduced by 50%
4. \$0.41 per electric customer per quarter for the first 4,000 customers, after which the charge will be reduced by 50%
5. \$0.033 per person living within the corporation limits of villages and cities as defined by the 2010 federal census, for storm water assets per quarter for the first 10,000 people, after which the charge will be reduced by 50%
6. \$0.08 per person living within the corporation limits of villages and cities as defined by the 2010 federal census, for other municipal assets per quarter for the first 10,000 people, after which the charge will be reduced by 50%. This may include but is not limited to parking meters, street lights, signs, tree inventories, sidewalks, recreational equipment, and cemetery information.
7. A 15% discount on Water, Sanitary Sewer and Electric fees for communities that enroll all three utilities in the GIS Cooperative

SECTION 3:

The funds necessary for payment of said premium are appropriated from the General, Electric, Sewer, and Water Funds. Each of these four funds will pay an equal share of 25% of the total cost.

SECTION 4: This ordinance is shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
