

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCES 21-2014 AND 42-2014 THAT SET THE VILLAGE
SEWER RATES AND CHARGES TO ESTABLISH A SINGLE-FAMILY EQUIVALENCY
SEWER USAGE CHARGE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Village residential sewer customer usage fees are based on each customer's water meter reading, and

WHEREAS, some Village residential sewer customers are not connected to the Village Water Utility system and lack a water meter on which to base their sewer usage, and

WHEREAS, Brewster Village Council desires to provide a residential sewer usage charge designated as a Single-Family Equivalency (SFE) sewer usage charge which is applicable to residential sewer customers that are not on the Village Water Utility system and lack a water meter on which to base the sewer usage.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: Brewster Village Council directs that Ordinances 21-2014 and 42-2014 shall be amended to establish a Single-Family Equivalency (SFE) Sewer Usage charge for sewer customers for whom the installation of a water meter is not practical or possible, and that the SFE charge be based on the average usage of all Village residential sewer customers

SECTION 2: Brewster Village Council directs that the Single-Family Equivalency (SFE) Sewer Usage charge for the remainder of 2019 be set at 4400 gallons per month and in each succeeding year at an amount of up to 6000 gallons per month. Village Council further directs that for each calendar year after 2019 the Village Administrator shall review the sewer usage of all metered residential water customers to establish the average gallons per month residential customer's usage that shall be the Single-Family Equivalency (SFE) Sewer Usage charge effective on January 1 of each calendar year.

SECTION 3: The revenue provided by the above Single-Family Equivalency (SFE) Sewer Usage charge will be appropriated to the Sewer Fund each month

SECTION 4: This ordinance is an emergency to allow the Stark County Sewer District to establish sewer service to a unincorporated area in a timely fashion and shall be in full force and effect on the earliest date provided by law.
