

**AN ORDINANCE CREATING A POLICE INCOME TAX FUND,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, at the November 8, 2016 General Election Brewster Voters approved the following measure: "Shall the ordinance providing for an increase in the Village of Brewster Municipal Income Tax rate from one percent (1%) to One and-One Half percent (1.5%) to be effective from January 1, 2017 for a period of five years, for the following purposes: two-tenths of One percent (0.2%) for the operation of the Village Police Department and three-tenths of One percent (0.3%) for the maintenance and construction of Village streets, be passed ?" ; and

WHEREAS, Brewster Village Council desires to create a separate Fund to designate received municipal income tax revenue from the two-tenths of One percent (0.2%) earmarked for the operation of the Village Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.12 requires the Ohio State Auditor's approval for all new funds established by a local government.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: The Village Clerk-Treasurer is hereby directed and authorized to take all the steps necessary or appropriate, in accordance with the Ohio Revised Code (O.R.C.) and the State Auditor's Office, to create a Village Fund to be designated as the Police Income Tax Fund.

SECTION 2: The source of revenue deposited into the Police Income Tax Fund shall be two-tenths of One percent (0.2%) of the revenue received from the 1.5 % Village Municipal Income Tax, and said funds shall be used solely for the operation of the Village Police Department.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be considered under emergency in order to be effective on January 1, 2017 and shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
