

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 37-2019 TO ESTABLISH A SINGLE-FAMILY
EQUIVALENCY SEWER RATE OF UP TO 6000 GALLONS FOR MANAGING SECTION
4.03 OF THE 2019 AGREEMENT BETWEEN STARK COUNTY AND VILLAGE OF
BREWSTER SANITARY SEWER AGREEMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Brewster Village Council and Stark County approved an agreement to provide sewer service to the residents in portions of Stark County in Sugar Creek Township in the vicinity of Justus Avenue and Keller Avenue under the Stark County Metropolitan Sewer District, and

WHEREAS, Brewster Village Council desires to establish a single-family equivalency sewer usage rate of up to 6000 gallons rather than a flat rate of 6,000 gallons per month as contained in Section 4.03 of the 2019 Agreement between Stark County and Brewster.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: With the approval of Ordinance # 51-2019 Brewster Village Council established a Single-Family Equivalency (SFE) Sewer Usage charge for sewer customers for whom the installation of a water meter is not practical or possible, and directed that the Single-Family Equivalency (SFE) Sewer Usage charge be based on the average usage of all Village residential sewer customers at 4400 gallons per month in 2019 and up to 6000 gallons per month each year thereafter.

SECTION 2: Ordinance # 51-2019 authorized and directed the Village Administrator to review the sewer usage of all metered residential water customers each year to establish the average gallons per month for residential customer's usage to set the Single-Family Equivalency (SFE) Sewer Usage charge for that calendar year effective with the January billing of each calendar year after 2019

SECTION 3: This ordinance is an emergency to allow the Stark County Sewer District to establish sewer service to a unincorporated area in a timely fashion and shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
