

**AN ORDINANCE THAT AUTHORIZES THE PURCHASE OF A 2020 CHEVROLET TAHOE
POLICE PURSUIT VEHICLE FROM GANLEY CHEVROLET FOR THE VILLAGE POLICE DEPARTMENT,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Brewster Village Council hereby declares that it is in the best interest of the Village of Brewster to purchase a new Police vehicle; and

WHEREAS, Brewster Village Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the Village to purchase a 2020 Chevrolet Tahoe Police Pursuit Vehicle from Ganley Chevrolet of Aurora, Ohio the State Bidder holder under the Ohio Department of Administrative Services' Cooperative Purchasing Program and as provided under Ohio Revised Code Section 125.04 and Section 731.14

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: The Village Administrator and Village Clerk are authorized to take all steps necessary to enter into a contract for the purchase of a 2020 Chevrolet Tahoe 4WD Police Pursuit Vehicle from Ganley Chevrolet of Aurora, Ohio at a contract price that shall not exceed \$ 35,981.80. Said contract for the 2020 Chevrolet Tahoe 4WD Police Pursuit Vehicle will be in accordance with the specifications submitted by Ganley Chevrolet to the Village dated May 28, 2019.

SECTION 2: Funds for the purchase of the 2020 Chevrolet Tahoe 4WD Police Pursuit Vehicle as well as the funds to make the vehicle road ready as a police vehicle shall be appropriated evenly from the Village Police Equipment Fund and the Police Income Tax Fund as directed by Council

SECTION 3: This ordinance is an emergency to allow timely delivery of the vehicle and shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
