

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO MAKE
PREPARATION FOR AND ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR THE EAST MAIN STREET
PAVING AND REHABILITATION PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Brewster Village Council has been advised that the 200 and 300 blocks of East Main Street that provides access to the Village's southeast residential neighborhoods as well as potential access to Fairless Schools as a part of the planned State Routes to Schools Project and the planned Stark County Trails Project is in need of modification and to provide a safer more cost effective roadway, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Brewster has been granted Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) funding up to \$ 51,964.00 (49%) of the estimated \$ 103,000 cost for the East Main Street Paving and Rehabilitation Project, and

WHEREAS, Brewster Village Council desires to pave and modify East Main Street as proposed for the current and future needs of the Village of Brewster's residents, students walking to Fairless Schools, and pedestrian and bicycling visitors to the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: Village Council authorizes the Village Administrator to take the following steps to prepare for and bid an East Main Street Paving and Rehabilitation Project:

- A. Competitively Bid the East Main Street Paving and Rehabilitation Project in accordance with all State of Ohio and Village law.
- B. Based on the received Bids, provide Council with a recommended Contractor for consideration for awarding a contract for completion of the project, via ordinance as prescribed by State Law.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is considered to be an emergency to allow timely bidding of the project to permit construction in favorable 2019 weather and shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
