

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE AWARDING OF A CONTRACT FOR THE  
2019 BREWSTER PAVING PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, Brewster Village Council desires to prepare and pave Village streets in 2019 through a 2019 Brewster Paving Project, and

**WHEREAS**, the advertisement for Bids for the completion of a 2019 Brewster Paving Project has been completed in accordance with all applicable laws, and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:**

**SECTION 1:** It is determined that Superior Paving & Materials of North Canton, Ohio was the lowest and best Bidder for the 2019 Brewster Paving Project. Brewster Village Council awards a contract to Superior Paving & Materials of North Canton, Ohio for the completion of the 2019 Brewster Paving Project in accordance with the specifications prepared by OHM Engineering on which the Bids were received for the contract price of \$ 160,728.05. The streets to be completed and the estimated cost based on the engineer's quantity estimates and the contractor's material costs for each are as follows:

**SECTION 2:** The Village Administrator and Village Clerk-Treasurer are authorized and directed to execute the contract with Superior Paving & Materials of North Canton, Ohio for the completion of the 2019 Brewster Paving Project in accordance with the specifications on which the Bids were received. An executed copy of the Contract shall be kept on file in the Village Clerk-Treasurer's Office.

**SECTION 3:** The cost of the preparation and paving of Elton Street SW will be funded through the Stark County Municipal Road Fund. The cost of the remaining roadways that comprise this project will be appropriated from and charged to the Village Street Improvement Fund.

**SECTION 4:** This ordinance is an emergency to allow the contractor to better take advantage of favorable construction weather and shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
