Resolution No. 55-2021 Passed November 1, 2021

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ENTERING INTO CONTRACT FOR THE WATER FILTER MEDIA REHABILITATION AND REPLACEMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Village of Brewster needs to make capital improvements to the Village's Water Department filter media vessels and replace the filter media, and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority for the community, and

WHEREAS, the Village has completed specifications for the Water Filter Media Rehabilitation and Replacement Project prior to submitted a request for OPWC Funding, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Brewster has received a OPWC grant in the amount of \$94,080 and a loan of \$62,720, totaling \$156,800, and

WHEREAS, the Brewster Village Council desires to move forward on the Water Filter Media Rehabilitation and Replacement Project as proposed, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Brewster has competitively bid the Water Filter Media Rehabilitation and Replacement Project in accordance with all State of Ohio and Village laws, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Brewster has received and opened bids, and


WHEREAS, based on the bids received, the Village's engineering firm on the project has provided Council with a recommended Contractor for the Water Filter Media Rehabilitation and Replacement Project, who is qualified under OPWC programs, for award of a contract for completion of the project

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: It is determined that Workman Industrial Services, Inc. of Kent, Ohio was the lowest and best Bidder for the Water Filter Media Rehabilitation and Replacement Project be awarded a contract in the amount of \$381,792.00.


SECTION 2: The Village Administrator and Village Clerk-Treasurer are authorized and directed to execute the contract with Workman Industrial Services, Inc. of Kent, Ohio for the completion of the Water Filter Media Rehabilitation and Replacement Project in accordance with the specifications on which the Bids were received. An executed copy of the Contract shall be kept on file in the Village Clerk-Treasurer's Office.


